- Data analysis (Grounded theory analytic techniques, Applied thematic analysis, Framework analysis), and Use of Qualitative Software (Hands-on crash course)
- Reporting qualitative research for thesis and publications

Rs.1000/- for masters/doctoral students; Rs. 2000/- for academic faculty or independent researchers. Participants will be provided workshop materials, refreshments, lunch, dinner and on-campus accommodation (twin-sharing) for three nights. Participants are required to take care of their travel-related expenses.

Eligibility and application:

MPhil/PhD scholars, independent researchers and early career University faculty with a background in public health, health and development, gender and health, socio-behavioural sciences, are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to those who are already involved in qualitative research (i.e., their thesis or study employs qualitative or mixed methods research). **The number of participants for this workshop is restricted to 20**. Applications should be sent by email with the following details: name, gender, University/college and department, name of Guide (for Doctoral students), topic and area of research, and other relevant information, including a short write-up (one paragraph) explaining why you would like to attend the workshop.
